### **Early Deadline Approaching for Pensacola Seafood Festival Applications**

**Pensacola, Fla. (May 29, 2013)** The deadline of June 3 is approaching for vendors to apply for the 36<sup>th</sup> annual Pensacola Seafood Festival to avoid a \$100 fee increase. To apply, vendors must visit the Seafood Festival website at [www.pensacolaseafoodfestival.com](http://www.pensacolaseafoodfestival.com) to select the type of application that best matches their product or craft. Vendors may submit applications for arts & crafts, food, commercial, embellished items and "Gulf to Table." The festival will be held September 27, 28, and 29 in historic Seville Square and has over 100,000 attendees, 180 artists and craftsmen from around the nation as well as nearly 30 vendors featuring local seafood.

Recognized as one of the Top 20 Festivals in the Southeast by the Southeast Tourism Society and Independent News' "Best of the Coast – Best Annual Food Event," the Pensacola Seafood is one of Pensacola's premier events held in downtown Pensacola. The festival also features live entertainment, a children's area, and much more.
